



SUFFOLK HALL OF FAME

The Suffolk sheep breed and its breeders are rich in history. Many members have impacted the breed, past associations, and the sheep industry. In 2013, the United Suffolk Sheep Association Board of Directors formed the United Suffolk Sheep Association Suffolk Hall of Fame to embrace, celebrate and honor those breeders who are historically influential to the Suffolk Breed. The USSA Suffolk Hall of Fame Committee welcomes nominations from the membership.

ELIGIBILITY

The conditions of eligibility are as follows:

- A person or family that has promoted, raised and/or contributed to the success of Suffolk sheep and ASSS/NSSA/USSA related experiences.
- Have raised Suffolk sheep, have been a member of and/or have provided exemplary service to the ASSS/NSSA/USSA. Longevity of raising Suffolks, membership and/or amount of service provided will be a major consideration when selecting individuals.
- The person submitting the nomination must be:
 - a current member in good standing
 - must provide evidence of the nominee's contribution to the success of Suffolk sheep or the United Suffolk Sheep Association
- The person submitting the nomination must provide evidence of the nominee's contribution to the success of Suffolk sheep.
- Current USSA staff and Directors will not be considered for nomination into the Hall of Fame while serving on the board
- If the nominee is not chosen during the submission year, the nomination will be considered active for a period of 5 years.
- The USSA Suffolk Hall of Fame Committee may select and recommend individuals who did not have a nomination form submitted for them.
- The award may be given posthumously. If the nominee is deceased, please provide the contact information for the individual who would be accepting the award on the deceased's behalf.
- The Hall of Fame Committee will submit their recommendations to the current USSA Board for final approval.
- Nominees will be selected nationally with no district requirements.

Any information provided may be shared with the public and/or the media. Nomination forms must be submitted by December 31st.
