



SUFFOLK HALL OF FAME NOMINATION

The Suffolk sheep breed and its breeders are rich in history. In 2013, the United Suffolk Sheep Association Board of Directors created the United Suffolk Sheep Association Suffolk Hall of Fame to embrace, celebrate and honor those breeders who influenced the Suffolk breed, its associations and the sheep industry. The USSA Suffolk Hall of Fame Committee welcomes nominations from members.

CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY FOR A PERSON OR A FAMILY

- Promoted, raised and/or contributed to the success of Suffolks.
- Involved with at least one of the following associated organizations:
 - American Suffolk Sheep Society (ASSS)
 - National Suffolk Sheep Association (NSSA)
 - United Suffolk Sheep Association (USSA)
- Current USSA staff and Directors will not be considered for nomination for the Hall of Fame. However, they may be considered after their current term or employment ends.
- Nominations of those not selected will be reconsidered for a period of 5 years.
- The USSA Suffolk Hall of Fame Committee may select and recommend individuals who did not have a nomination form submitted for them.
- The award may be presented posthumously. If the nominee is deceased, please provide contact information for the individual accepting the award on the deceased's behalf.
- The Hall of Fame Committee submits their recommendation(s) to the current USSA Board for final approval.
- Nominees will be selected nationally with no district requirements.

 - American Suffolk Sheep Society
 - National Suffolk Sheep Association
 - United Suffolk Sheep Association

 - United Junior Suffolk Sheep Association
- Contribution to the success of Suffolk sheep
- Involvement with State Suffolk Associations
- Service to community and state events which support Suffolk breeders
- Historical contributions to the success of the Suffolk breed
- Impact made on the Suffolk commercial sheep industry
- Impact on the show ring
- Contributed to the advancement of the Suffolk breed through research, development, and/or education.
- Impact on the Suffolk breed at a local, regional or national level
