FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Can anyone attend The Event?

Yes, anyone can attend The Event. Registration is required; USSA and UJSSA members have a discounted registration fee.

How much will the registration fee cost?

Member fees are \$50 per adult and \$30 per child under the age of 12. This covers the cost of all educational sessions, the welcome dinner on Friday night and the banquet/kids pizza party Saturday night. Non-member registration fees are \$75 per person.

Can I still join the USSA or UJSSA?

Yes, membership is open year-round. Contact the USSA Office to learn more!

Will there be meals provided at The Event?

There will be at least two meals included with each registration – a welcome supper Friday night and dinner at the Hall of Fame banquet on Saturday evening.

Will there be a show to determine sale order?

There will not be a show determining a sale order. The committee is creating a interactive way for the attendees to observe the sale sheep and participate in setting the sale order. Details coming soon.

Will there be a presentation requirement for the sale sheep?

No, sheep may be presented in any way the consignor desires. It is likely there will be sheep presented as fitted, slick shorn or in a 30-45 day fleece.

Will the junior show have fitted and slick shorn classes?

Yes, both will be offered.

Will there be youth activities?

Yes, the following will be offered:

- Youth track offered for the educational sessions
- Corn hole tournament during the Friday welcome reception/sale preview
- Kids activities/supper in a room adjacent to the Hall of Fame banquet
- Junior show on Sunday

Do you have to enter sale sheep or junior sheep to attend?
